COVID-19 UPDATE

Changes to retirement village social distancing restrictions

The Queensland Government has announced that from Saturday 16 May there will be some changes to social distancing rules. As a result of those changes, we have eased some social distancing restrictions in place at our retirement villages.

These are now open...

- **Libraries** – All village libraries are now open for borrowing books, but not for other activities. Only two people may be in the library at one time with social distancing to be observed.
- **Pools and spas** – The pool at The Plains and the spa at Janoah Gardens are now open. Only two people may be in the pool at one time, with social distancing to be observed.
- **Playground and BBQ area** – The playground and BBQ area at The Plains is now open. Up to 10 people may be in this area at one time with social distancing to be observed.

These continue to remain closed...

- **Village cafes** - These remain closed until further notice
- **Village halls** – These remain closed until further notice. At Beth Eden the library is in the village hall, so only the library section of the hall is open for borrowing books as mentioned above.
- **Village buses** – Village bus trips remain cancelled until further notice.
